Bass Tournament Regulations

Thank you for registering for our BASSTOBERFEST Bass Fishing Tournament! The following rules and regulations are designed to keep the tournament honest and fair for all competitors. We also want to keep the event safe for all our participants and volunteers. By participating in this tournament, and with your signature on the entry form and release of liability form, you agree to abide by these rules, as they are laid out.

1. All participants agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the fishing and boating legislation of Ontario, as well as these rules of the BASSTOBERFEST Bass Fishing Tournament. Only fully completed entry forms, with all fields filled in, including signature, will be considered a completed entry form. An additional liability form will be required to be completed by both competitors.
2. All fish must be caught in Conestogo Lake. The tournament director may conduct livewell checks before the tournament begins. As this is a "live-release" tournament, all boats are required to have an aerated live-well to keep a tournament limit of 4 bass alive. If your vessel does not have an onboard live-well, a big cooler, with an aeration pump, will suffice. Please check with the official Tournament Director the morning of the event to make sure your vessel and aeration will be sufficient. The maximum horsepower allowed on any boat in this event is 250 hp.
3. The tournament hours are 9 A.M. to 2 P.M. Normal entry fees and launching fees to Conestogo Lake will be required to access the lake.
4. All fish caught during the event will be weighed in at the dock where competitors launched. The tournament limit will be four (4) bass, per boat. Only smallmouth and largemouth bass will be allowed to be weighed. Any other species of fish hooked and landed must be released back into the lake immediately. The official minimum length of bass shall be 12 inches, nose to tip. Any bass presented for weigh-in that fails to measure the official length, shall accrue penalties of one (1) pound for each such bass (fish will not be weighed). In the event you have a dead fish, you **MUST NOT** release it, it must be brought to the scale. You will be penalized one (1) pound for each such bass (fish **WILL** be weighed).
5. Only one fishing rod may be used per person at one time. More rods may be in the boat ready for use, but only **ONE** is permitted in use at any given time. All bass must be caught live and in a conventional sporting manner. Anyone guilty of snatching or snagging visible fish will have their entire day's catch disqualified. Only artificial lures

may be used in this event (no live bait of any kind). The organizers will allow the use of landing nets to land bass for the safety of the angler and the fish.

6. Safe conduct must be observed at all times by tournament competitors during the tournament, including pre-tournament setup, registration, and weigh-in activities.
7. Each competitor is required to wear a Canadian Coast Guard Approved PFD, or floatation suit/jacket. This preserver **MUST** be worn anytime the combustion engine is operating. This includes **BEFORE** the combustion engine is started. This preserver must be strapped, snapped, or zippered securely and maintained in that condition until the competitors reach their fishing location and the combustion engine is shut off. Violation of this rule shall be reason for disqualification. Inflatable PFD's are permitted to be used but **MUST BE WORN** at all times. They cannot be removed unless there is a visible vest-type PFD or life jacket on the deck of the boat for the owner of the inflatable PFD. The safety of all competitors is our highest priority.
8. All decisions of the Tournament Director, and/or Organizing Committee will be final. The Tournament Director has the right to confer with other committee members to reach his final decision, in the event an issue arises.
9. All awards and raffle prizes will be awarded at the Alpine Club, 464 Maple Ave., Kitchener, Ontario, after the fishing portion of BASSTOBERFEST has been completed. (For this event, the Alpine Club will be known as Habsburg Haus). We will have an Oktoberfest themed atmosphere for the competitors at Habsburg Haus. Winning competitors, and raffle prize winners, will be notified by phone or email if not in attendance at Habsburg Haus.
10. Remember, there is zero tolerance for alcohol or drug use at this event! We will be inviting the O.P.P. Marine Unit to attend the event.
11. You are responsible for having the proper Ontario Fishing Licence to participate in this event. The organizers will not be responsible for any situation that may arise due to your lack of a licence, or providing the wrong licence.
12. None of the above rules shall prohibit a properly designated tournament official from approaching any competitor's vessel at any time during the official competition day. By signing the application form, you agree to allow any and all recording, both visual and vocal, for advertising reasons, promotions, and publications of any kind.

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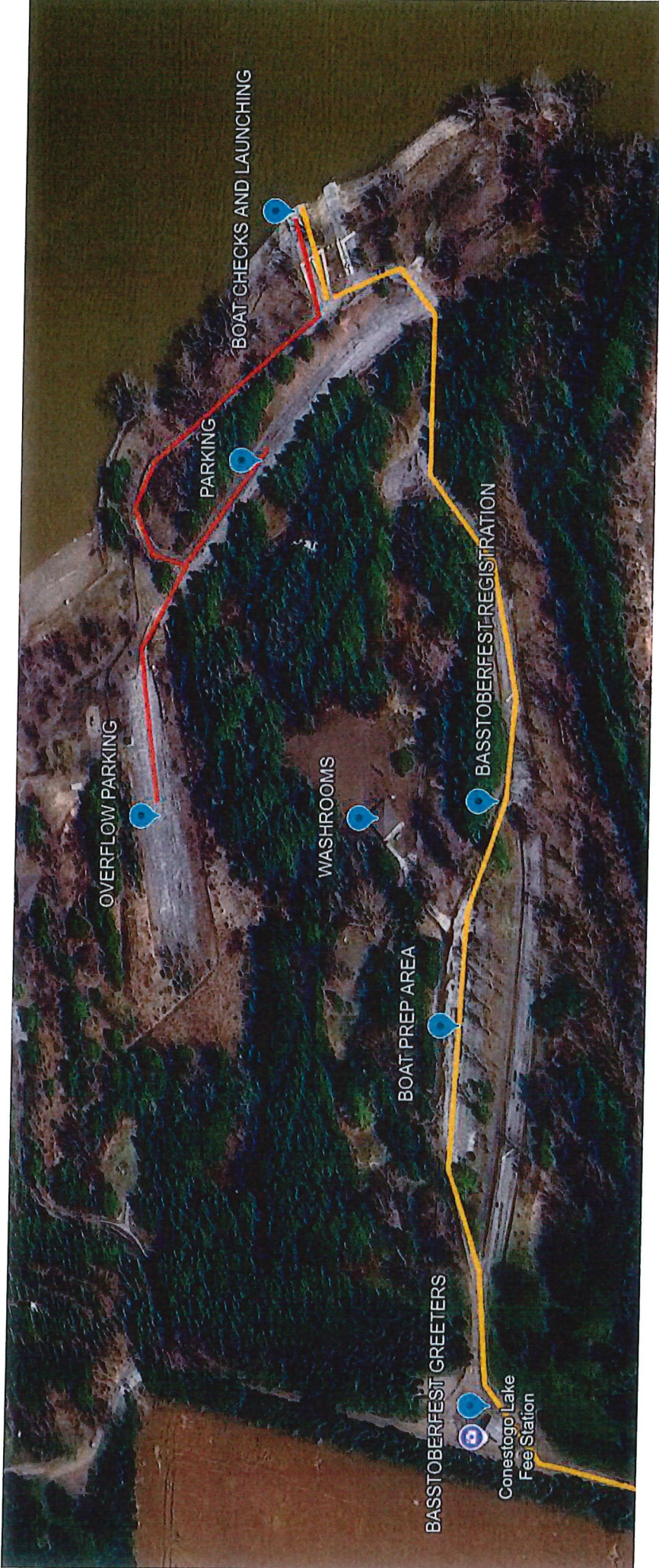
